Based upon the recommendation from Ken Sande’s Peacemaker Ministries, the Elders and Leadership Board unanimously recommend the following bylaw change:

PROPOSED CHANGES TO CROSSPOINTE BYLAWS HIGHLIGHTED IN **YELLOW**

Article V – Membership

Section B. Responsibilities of Membership – Covenant of Fellowship

Members of this congregation commit themselves by the help and guidance of the Holy Spirit:

- To resolve and allow the full resolution of any spiritual conflicts or sin resulting in church discipline consistent with the pattern of scripture (Matt. 18: 15-20).

Section F. Termination of Membership

2. By request. Requests for removal from the membership of Crosspointe Christian Church, shall be considered and acted upon by the Council of Elders.

The Council of Elders shall conduct, or arrange to have conducted, an interview to ascertain the reason for the request for removal. Any subsequent removal shall be reported to the church. Requests shall be in writing or, if oral, shall be confirmed in writing by the church. The Council of Elders may deny the request if it is made while the requesting member is under church discipline as described in subsection 4, below.

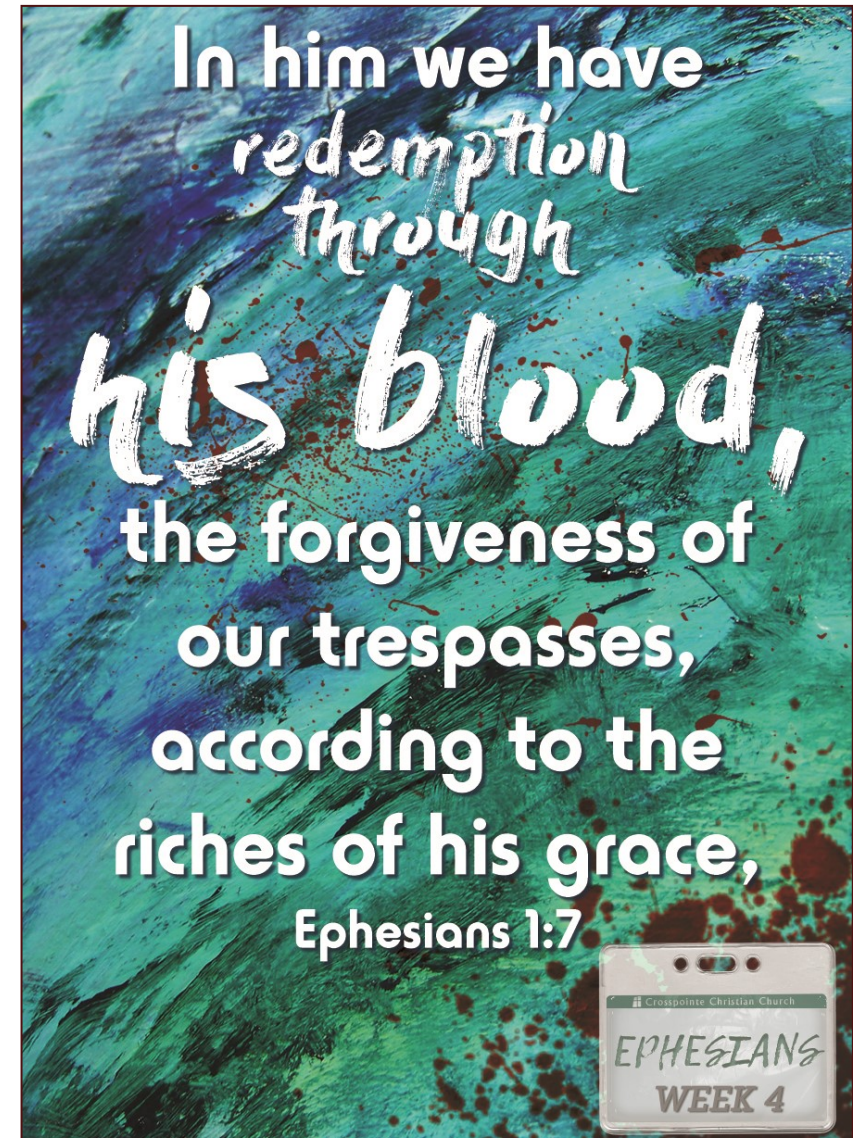
