If you responded to one of the three "next steps" that we identified today which one was it. If not, have you already taken these steps in your life? In what way?

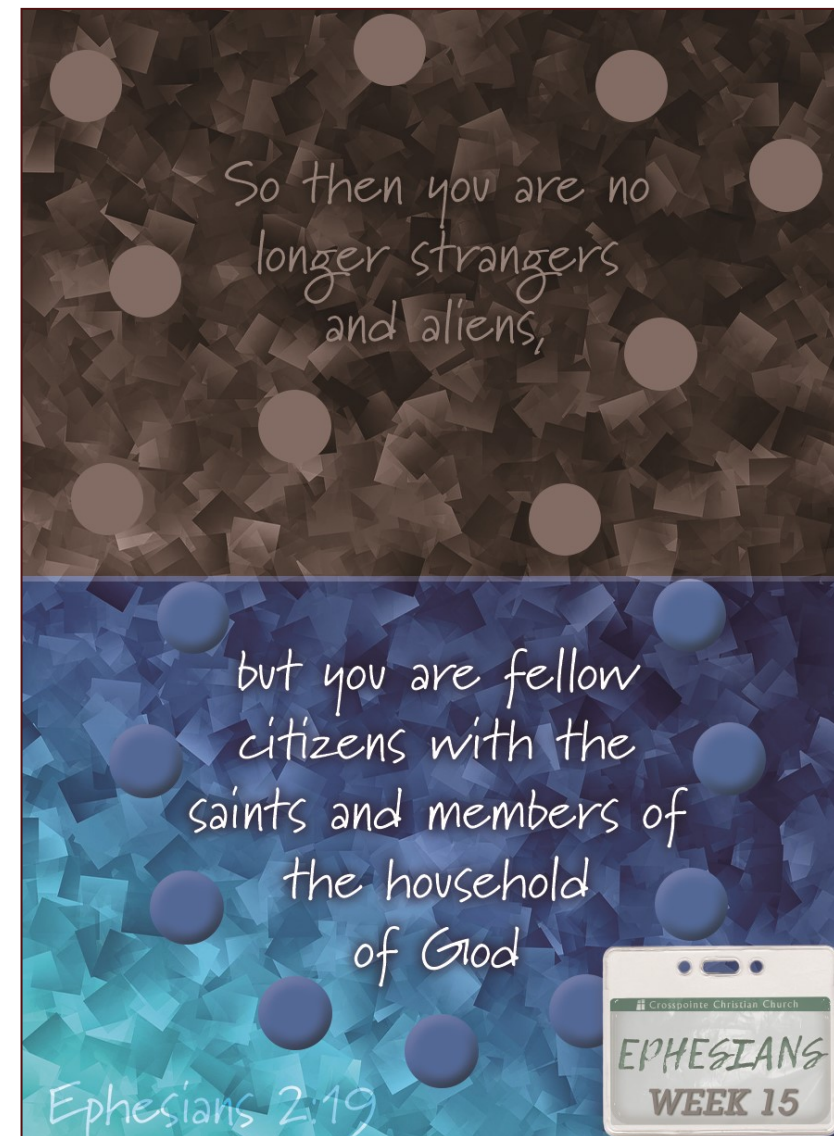
Think of someone you know who is longing to feel as though they have a home. Be in prayer for them this week and look for ways to begin to share the truth of Christ with them.
