Some Important Questions

Who wrote this book?

What kind of writing is this?

What are the main themes of Ephesians?

1) Unity

2) Identity

To learn more about Paul, read the following passages from the New Testament: Acts 8-9; 13; Galatians 1.11-2.21; Philippians 3.2-10. What did you learn about Paul?

Read through the entire book of Ephesians and make a note of each passage that talks about either identity or unity. Journal your thoughts on these passages, specifically about what new insights you might have gained.

Grace and Peace are two important words for believers. How would you define those words? How can you practice gracefulness and peacefulness in your life? What could you do differently in light of the peace and grace you have experienced?
