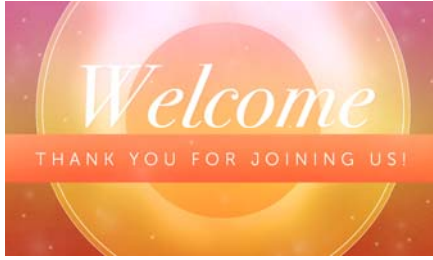

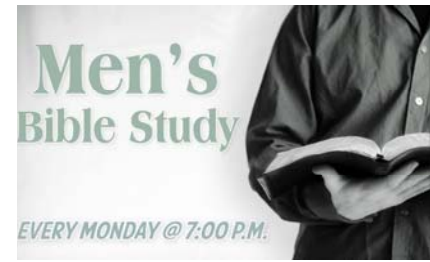


VBS Registration is Open
