

Remember that while rebellion comes from our hearts, redemption comes from our God!

On Your Own or with Your Family

Read Hosea. Read it several times. Make notes of questions and thoughts. Pay special attention to the reasons that God is going to send judgment.

The concept of "covenant" is lost in our culture in many ways. Marriage should be a covenantal relationship. At Crosspointe we have a "Covenant of Fellowship." To learn more about what a covenant is, consider this article: http://www.ligonier.org/learn/articles/what-covenant/

In what way has God made his expectations of us clear? Consider the following passages: 1 Thessalonians 5.12-22; 1 Corinthians 6.9-20; Colossians 3.

Sometimes we may think that someone is beyond redemption, yet the Bible is full of examples that no one is beyond redemption (think of Paul, David, the thief on the cross). Who have you "written off?" Start praying for them that they will come to Christ and that you will have an opportunity to share with them.


