the cross). Who have you "written off?" Start praying for
them that they will come to Christ and that you will have
an opportunity to share with them.

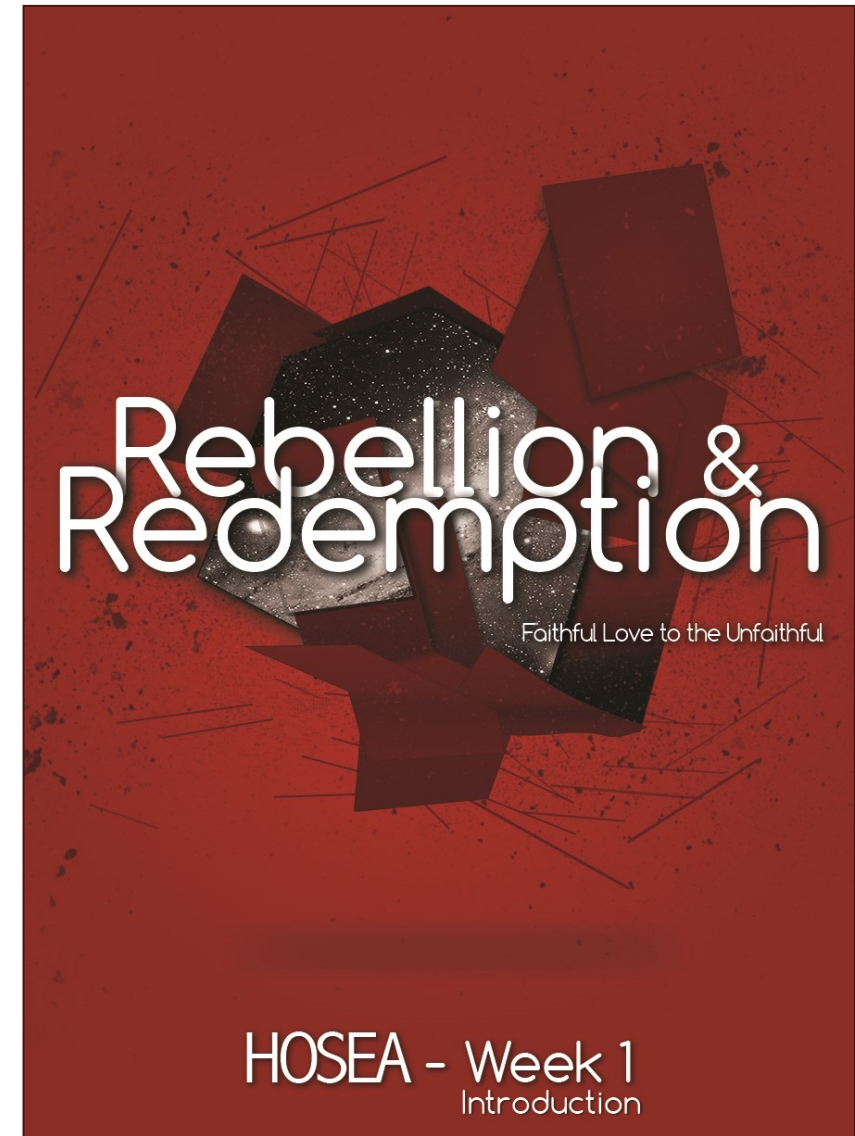
