Grosse Pointe Nursery School is now enrolling for Summer Camp programs for children age 2 1/2 through 10 years old. Contact the GPNS

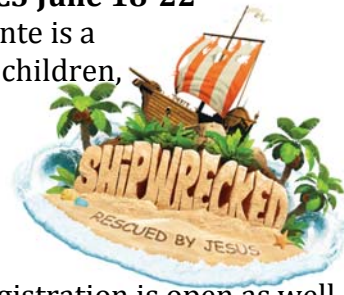
