VBS Shipwrecked

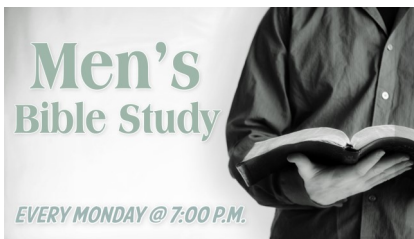

Pastor Matt's Notes Are All the Pages in Your Bible? A Call to Purity. Ephesians 5:1-6 June 10, 2018

1. The prerequisite motivation for _____.
2. _____ things God's children _____ eliminate from their lives.

A. Sexual immorality- Porneia (immorality) refers to all sexual sin, pornography, premarital sex, adultery or marital unfaithfulness.

1 Corinthians 7:2 But because of the temptation to sexual immorality, each man should have his own wife and each woman her own husband.

B. All impurity- a more general term than porneia, referring to anything that is unclean and impure, including homosexuality and every other form of sexual corruption.

C. Covetousness-It generally refers to greed for money but is really much broader than that. It means strong, inordinate craving, an inability to be content and satisfied with the things of God.

Philippians 4:19 They have become callous and have given themselves up to sensuality, greedy to practice every kind of impurity. 20 But that is not the way you learned Christ!

D. Filthiness- Has to do with general dirty speech.

Colossians 3:8 But now you must put them all away: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and obscene talk from your mouth.

E. Foolish talk- Sometimes referred to as low obscenity, foolish talk has no point except to give an air of dirty worldliness.

Proverbs 15:2 The tongue of the wise commends knowledge, but the mouths of fools pour out folly.

F. Crude joking- Carries the idea of quickly turning something that is said or done—no matter how innocent—into that which is obscene or suggestive.

Mark 7:21 For from within, out of the heart of man, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality...

3. The replacement for impurity- _____.

Hebrews 11:24 By faith Moses, when he was grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, 25 choosing rather to be mistreated with the people of God than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin. 26 He considered the reproach of Christ greater wealth than the treasures of Egypt...

4. The _____ of impurity?

1 John 2:19 They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us. But they went out, that it might become plain that they all are not of us.

Hebrews 4:13 And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account.
