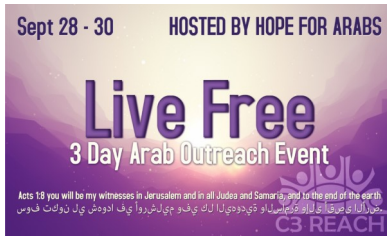


Welcome to Crosspointe!

On Your Own or with Your Family

Christ’s love for the church is to be our prototype for the love of a husband. Read through the Gospel of John and note each time Jesus does something that you would consider “loving.” What can we learn about the love of a husband from these observations.

How have you seen love and respect abused in marriage relationships? What can keep us from doing the same?

How would you counsel (using Scripture) someone who said they just could not love their wife any longer or respect their husband?

Set a time aside as a married couple for these two questions: Husband to your wife: **What do you wish I would do that would express my love for you?** Wife to husband: **What do you wish I would do that express my respect for you?**
