Living for God's glory alone is a difficult task. What are some "other glories" that we are tempted to live for today?

One way to keep our focus on God's glory is to remind ourselves of how glorious God is. Read through Isaiah 6.1-13. What pictures of God's glory and holiness in this passage might help us to remember how glorious God is?

Consider how God's saving grace has been apparent throughout all of Scripture (in the Garden, during the flood, in the time of Esther, in Christ). Are there other examples of God's saving grace in Scripture?

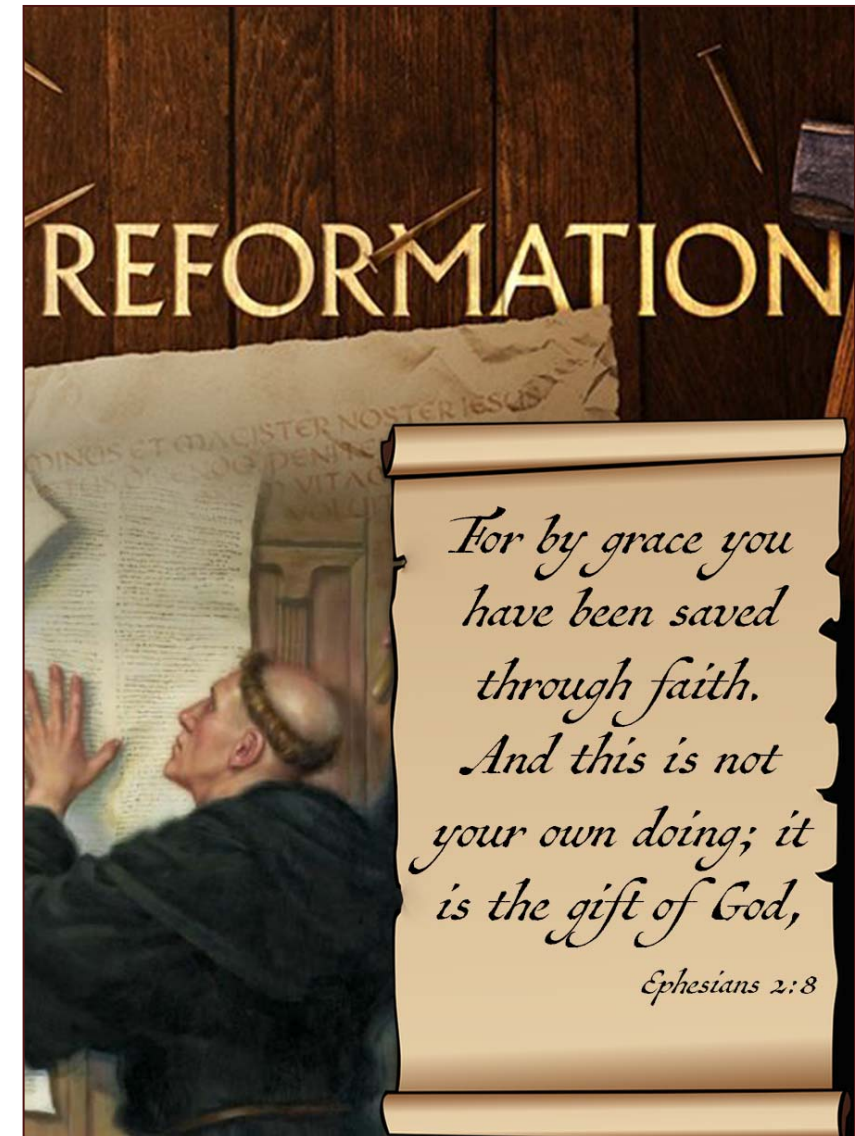
