A Worthy Walk
Ephesians 4.1-3
November 12th, 2017

I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, 2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, 3 eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Questions to Consider

Where can we show strength under control rather than a controlling strength?

Where can we bear others up rather than pushing them aside?

Where can we demonstrate an eagerness for peacemaking rather than a willingness for conflict?

On Your Own or with Your Family

Take some time to look up the passages suggested from the book of Proverbs. What do these verses say about each of these aspects of a “worthy walk?”

The best example of these three characteristics is Jesus Christ. Can you think of specific example from Jesus’ life where He demonstrated each of these characteristics?

Do you consistently demonstrate an eagerness to pursue peace? Are there specific relationships within the church where you have not pursued peace like you should? Make a plan this week to begin the process of repairing that relationship through peacemaking. (Crosspointe has an entire sermon series dedicated to peacemaking that can be found on our website).
